“The Evolution of the Internet”



- The mobile devices will be the primary connections of the Internet
- Voice recognition and touch interfaces will be more prevalent and accepted by 2020
- Divisions between personal and work time, between physical and virtual reality will blur

Interesting facts about the Zettabyte Scale:

Petabyte = 1,000 Terabytes or 250,000 DVDs!

1 Exabyte = 1,000 Petabytes or 250 million DVDs.

Internet traffic will exceed 27 Exabytes per month in 2012.

High-end devices will drive traffic growth.

YouTube and Hulu Generate 2x more traffic than the entire internet backbone in 2000.

Traffic at U.S. Public Internet Exchanges jumped over 40% during the Inauguration because so many people watched the event on the internet.

The Virtual World will have a great impact on the future of the Internet using Telepresence and Telpresence Magic. Telepresence is video conferencing using high definition screens that show people in another location. There will be less travel required to conduct business because virtual conferencing will give an in-person experience. Telepresence Magic will bring anyone in the world virtually, using the internet and cameras that give a 3D image of people standing in a certain area. It will appear more realistic because it is further enhanced. It will be piped via a high speed connection and shot up against a big screen.
