In 1987 they moved to Boston, MA, where she became Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs. In 1990 they moved to Hayward when she became CSUH President.

Norma has chaired many positions in her years with Hayward Rotary and spearheaded our service to the Salvation Army on "A" St. A great supporter of events that involve education to children, she continues to teach us all. Within the community, **Norma** was appointed to the Governor's School-To-Career Advisory Council, on which she served until 2002. While spearheading the university's Transitional Executive MBA Programs in Moscow, Austria, Hong Kong, Singapore and Beijing, the schools worldwide status has attracted students from at least 144 nations.
