Speaker today was Joel Bartlett, Retired Weather Forecaster for KPIX-TV 5 and KGO Radio, Channel 7.



Joel's career broadcasting the weather began in 1975 by accident. He went to college in Georgia and trained to be a mechanical engineer. He went into the Air Force where they found "his head foggy and breezy" and sent him to weather forecasting school at University of Texas. In the Air Force he would work different shifts at any time depending on when the pilots were flying.

From there he went to work for PG& E's weather office. Yes, PGE does look at the weather. Joel also sails. As he and his partner were sailing off the Golden Gate they were shipwrecked and made the news surviving 100mph winds off Mt. Tam.

Although they got off their broken boat and stepped onto the rocks. Joel said "Anyone who can sail SF Bay can sail anywhere".

He was noticed by the program manager at Channel 5 and asked to audition for the weekend weather report. He got that job in 1989 and quickly moved to the weekly weather.

Years later he was approached by the news director at Channel 7 about doing an environmental report and the weather. He accepted that offer and retired from Channel 7.

He learned that: "severe storms are generated only in Washington DC.

By reading Mark Twain he knew that "thunder is good but lightning does the work. So try to be enlightening".

His key points in reporting the weather are: A. Accuracy. "He's never been wrong, although may be off a year or two". B. Brief. If you go over time the sports reporter will be waiting. C. Communication. How you report will vary around the country. He accidentally got his trademark by flipping a pen.

The weather reporting used to be about having people like you. It is more professional now with more meteorologists reporting than entertainers.

For those who follow the farmer's almanac, he feels it is more entertainment and doesn't rely on it.
