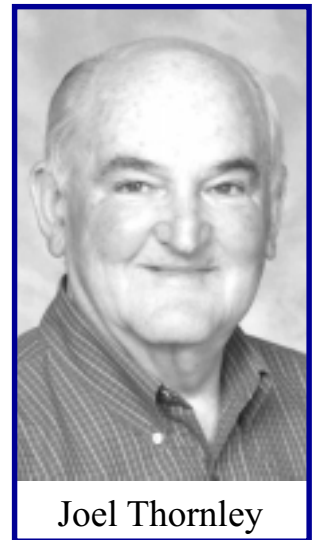
**How to protect yourself
