Program

Our program for this week was Vera Dahle Lacaze from the City of Hayward working with Solid Waste Management on how business can recycle in Hayward. She came with a variety of blue, lime green and gray bins and materials to demonstrate the types of things that are and are not recyclable. The city of Hayward has hired a consultant to assist business in setting up recycling programs and education for them. 350 new Hayward businesses have signed up since January. We are diverting as much as 60% of the waste from the landfill between business and residential recycling.

Hayward businesses receive recycling collection at no extra charge and organics recycling at half price. Vera discussed the coding of plastics from 1-7 and that in this area much of the 3-7 plastics go to other countries on the Pacific Rim and are turned into things such as carpeting and jacket fillings. She encouraged businesses to take advantage of the educational programs and posters available for distribution to employees.
